# United Women in Faith


On **Sunday, April 21**, join United Women in Faith and the Mission Committee for a program on Ukrainian refugees who are living in the Traverse City area of Michigan. Alline Beutler will be with us for worship at 9:00 and will give a presentation in the Chapel following the service. Immigration Law and Justice (ILJ-MI) is the new name for what was Justice for Our Neighbors (JFON). Come learn about this important ministry.

Mission Trip to Midwest Missions: Tuesday, May 28 - Saturday, June 1

It's an 8 hour drive to Midwest Missions in Central Illinois. We will be working with our Partners that we have put on the last two onsite Feed Ukraine events. We will be staying on site in private rooms at the onsite dormitory. We have 6 rooms reserved and room for 4 more people to go. The estimated cost for the trip including transportation, room and meals (except dinners) is \$150-200/person. Members that went last year were Rev. Yum, the Juengels, Talbots, and Hydes. Feel free to talk to any of last year's participants if you have questions about the work we did or the accommodations provided. This year we have seven folks already signed up but are looking for 4 more to go. A \$100 deposit will be due **4/15/24** if you are interested in joining this Mission Team.
