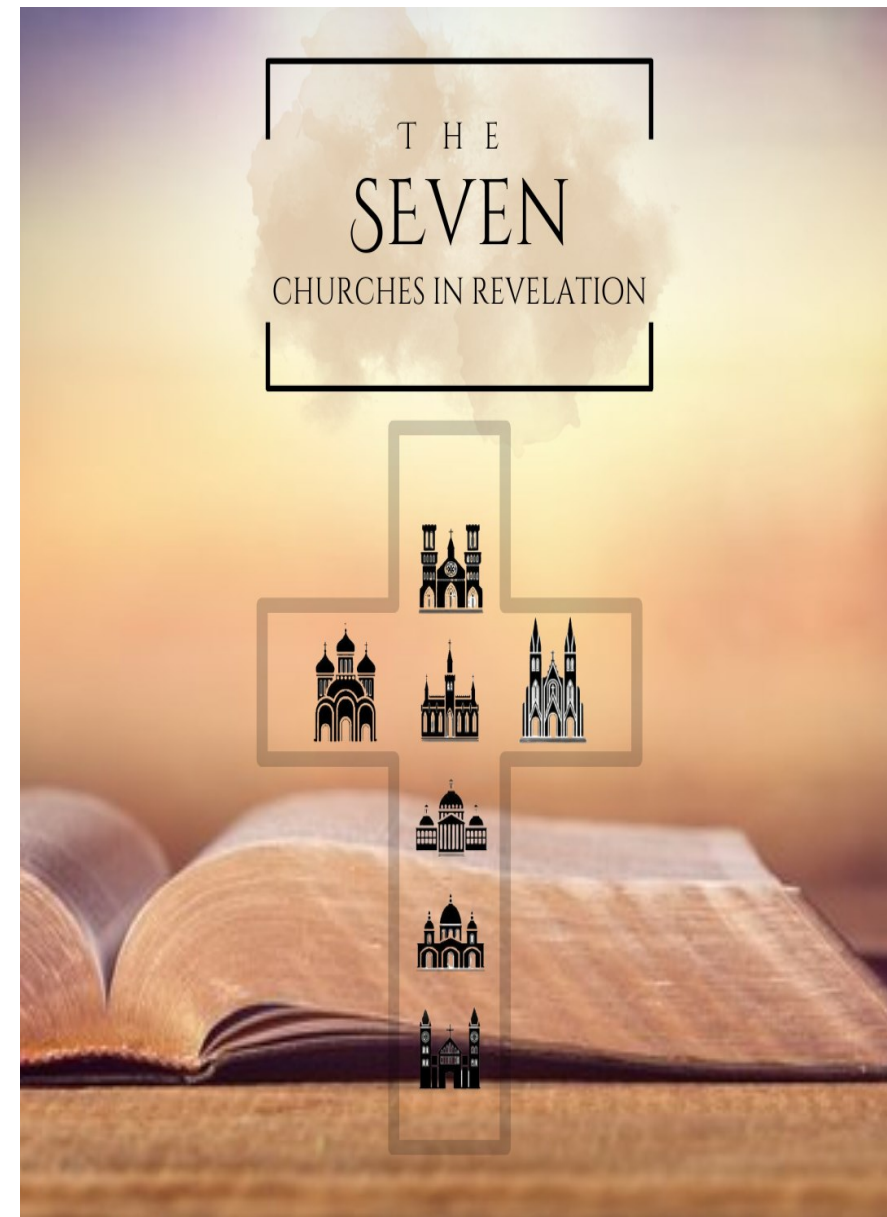


**Home to Stay Fundraiser Luncheon**
