

TONIGHT! - Annual Church Conference - October 27, 2024

The Annual Church Conference of Midland First UMC will be on October 27, 2024, at 6 p.m. This will occur at St. Charles UMC (301 W Belle Ave, St. Charles, 48655) in conjunction with the Church Conferences of other UMCs in our district zone. The Rev. John Kasper, District Superintendent of the Central Bay District, will preside over these church conferences.

Church Conferences are yearly gatherings that enable churches to look at their life together over the past year while conducting business necessary for the year ahead. This work includes voting on the nominations of leaders, continuing laity as Lay Servants, Speakers, or Ministers, conducting the annual evaluation of appointed cleray and setting their compensation, and more.

All congregation members are invited to participate in a Church Conference. However, following The Book of Discipline, only the gathered professing members of a local church are allowed to vote on matters requiring a vote.
